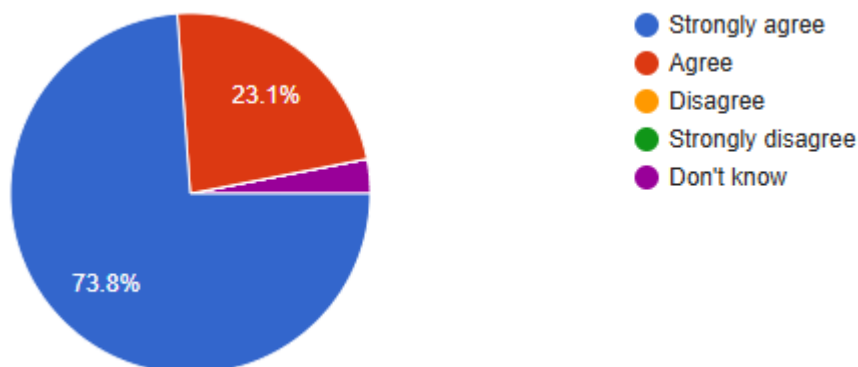

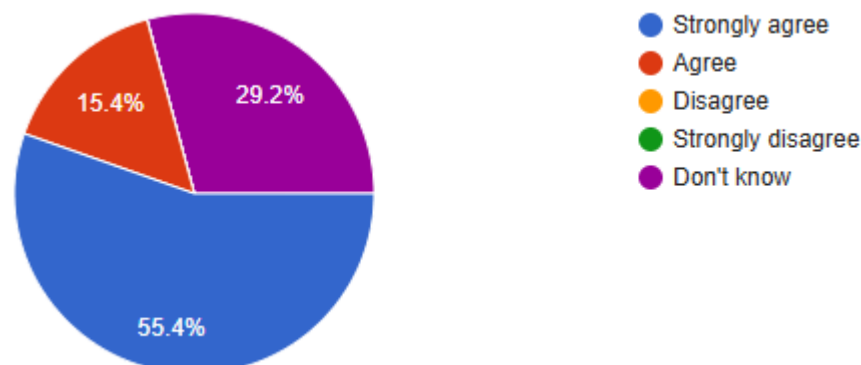
2. My child feels safe at Woodlands



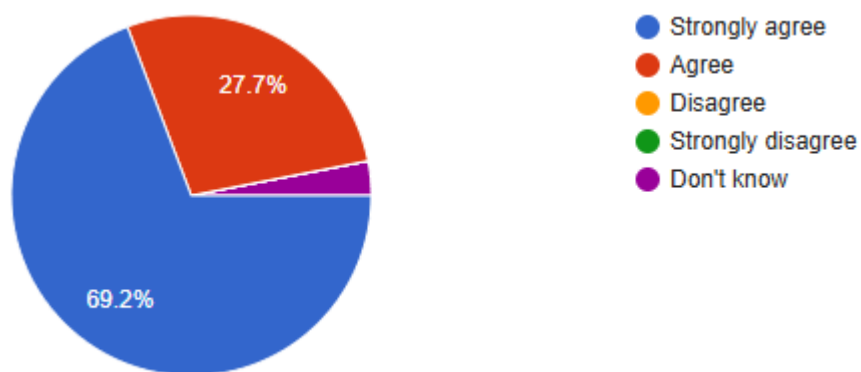

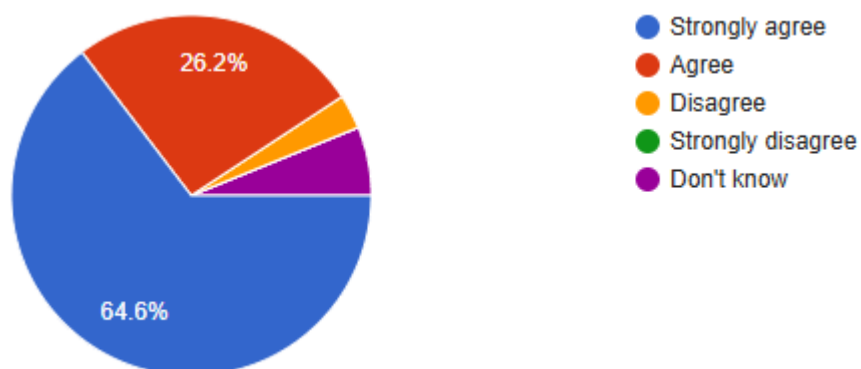

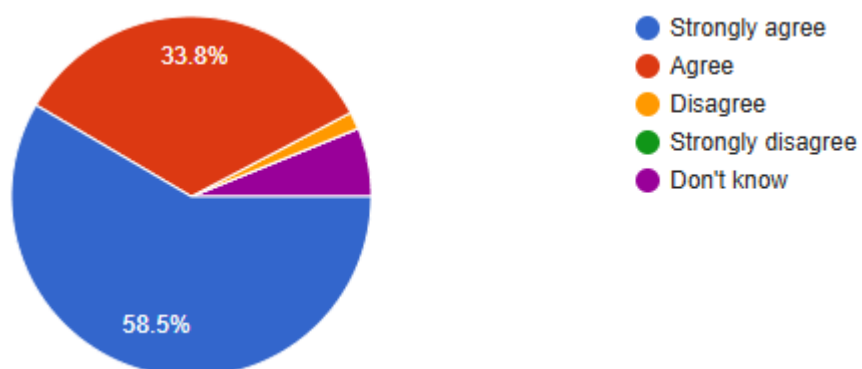

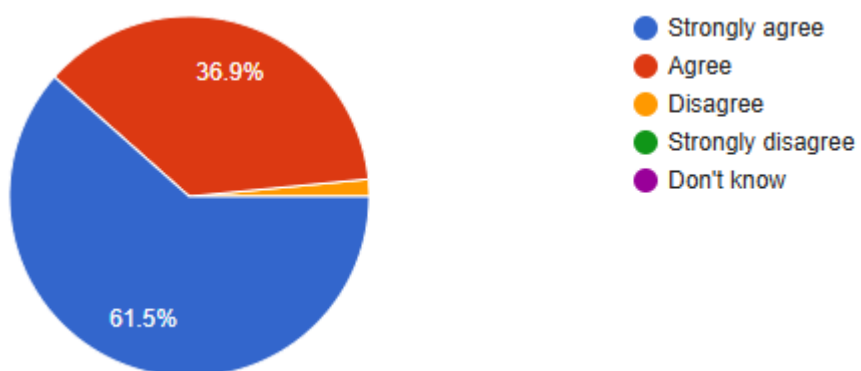

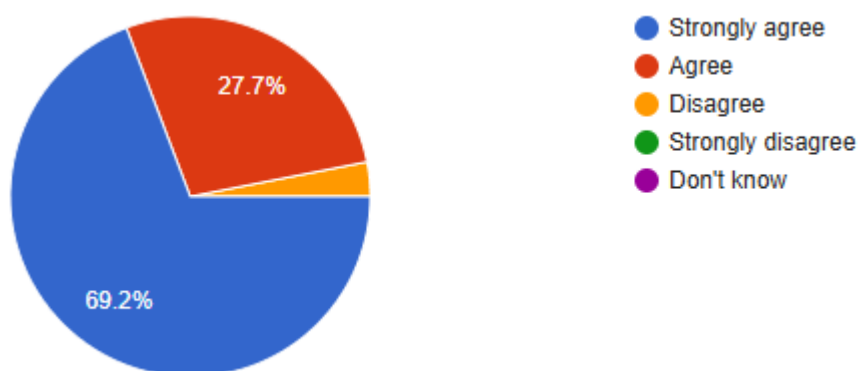

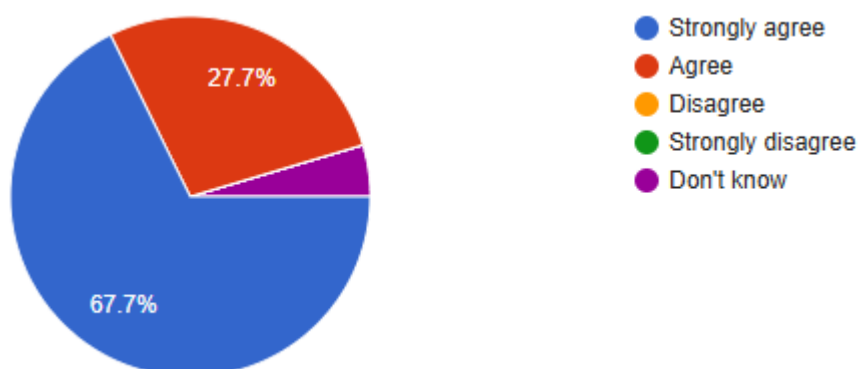

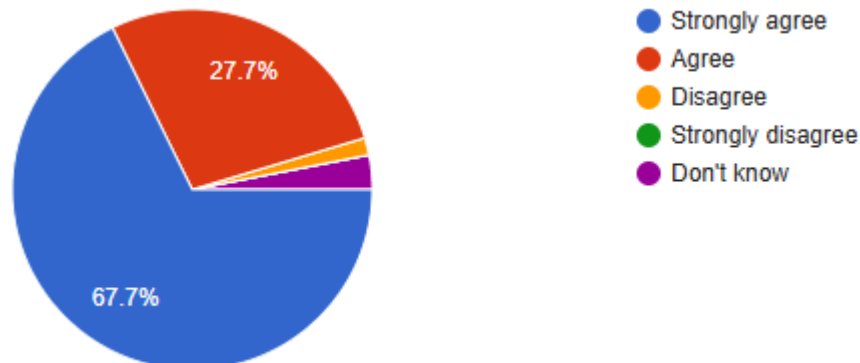

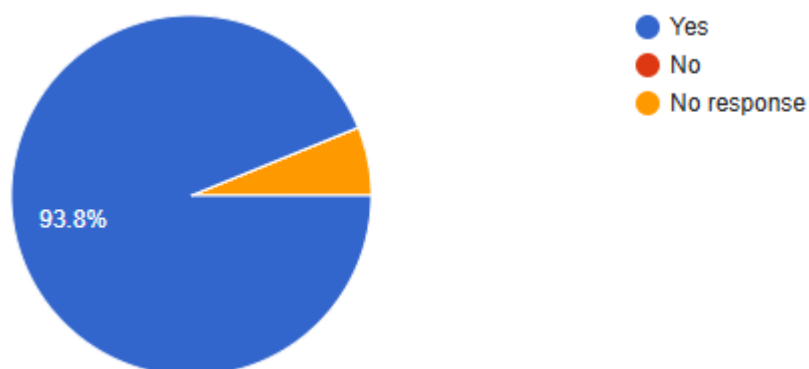
