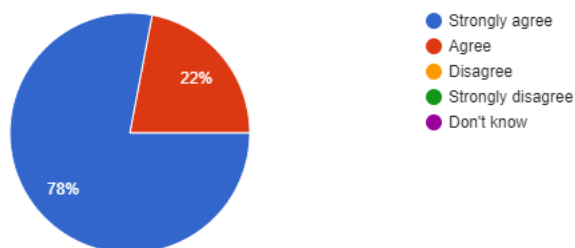


Parental survey – November 2022

Parents were requested to complete the survey during the two Open Evening events in November 2022; Surveys were sent home to those parents unable to attend these meetings at school.

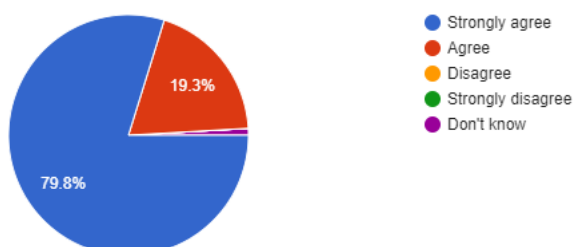
My child is happy at Woodlands

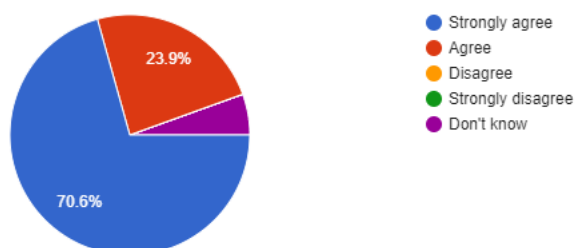
My child feels safe Woodlands

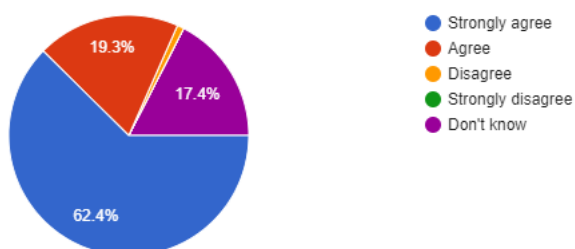
The school encourages the students to be well behaved

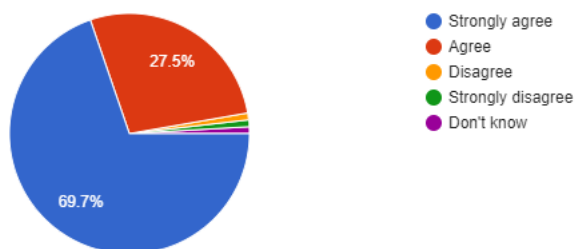
The school deals effectively with bullying

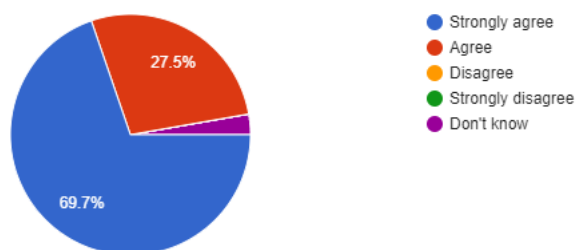
The school informs me what my child will be learning

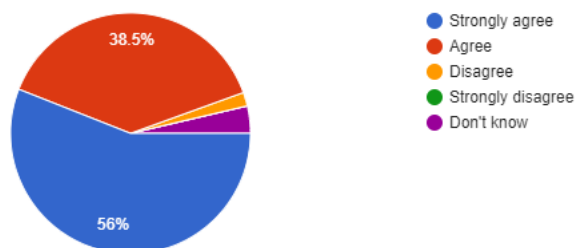
When I have raised concerns they have been dealt with properly.

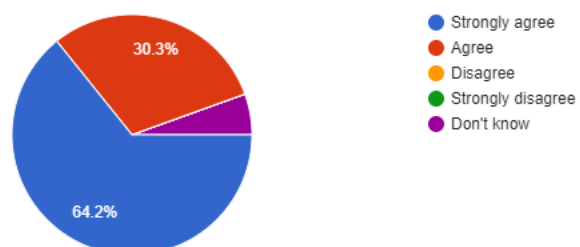
Woodlands has high expectations of my child

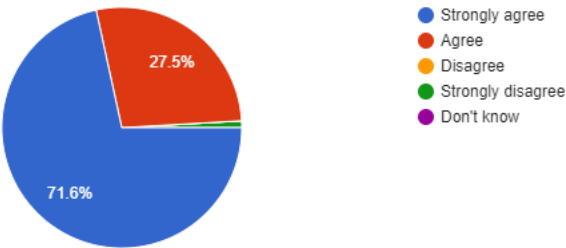
My child is doing well at school

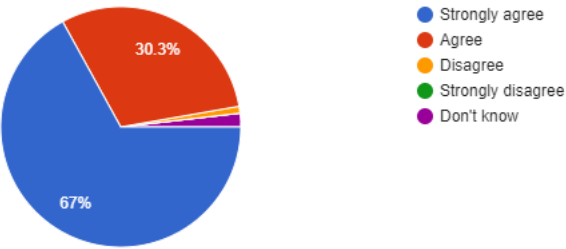
The school lets me know how my child is doing

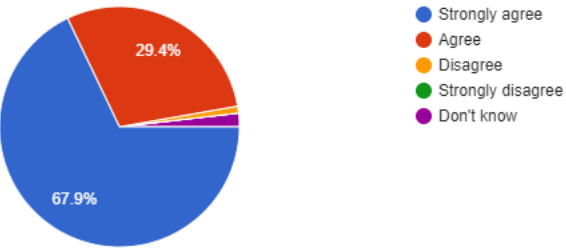
My child accesses appropriate learning opportunities at school

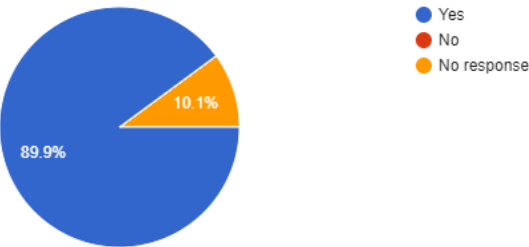
Woodlands school supports my child's wider personal development
